2. Chapter division of Imagina

- Spanish 303 completes chapters 1-5
- Spanish 304 completes chapters 6-10
- Spanish 305 completes chapters 1-10

Teachers who finish material early are free to assign outside texts and activities which may include additional literature, film, current events, presentations, oral exams, etc.

3. Compositions

- Spanish 303 and 304 students will write (4) compositions each semester.
- Spanish 305 students will write (8) compositions each semester.
- It is the instructor's discretion to decide how to distribute the compositions among *Imagina*'s assigned chapters.
- To help students transition from 211, the first composition should be at least 250 words (or longer at the instructor's discretion) and increase to at least 350 words by the end of the semester. A drafting process (or revision) is required for two compositions and the draft (or revision) is valued at 20-40% of the total composition grade.
